

How to become a STREAMS scholar.

In order to receive a STREAMS scholarship you must meet the following criteria:

- Have demonstrable financial need per FAFSA
- Be an undergraduate student majoring in ESP at USFSP
- Be U.S. citizens or permanent residents (green-card holders)
- Complete STREAMS application form available Jan 1, 2008 at <http://www.stpt.usf.edu/streams>
- Have at least a 2.5 GPA to be considered
- Women and minorities are encouraged to apply

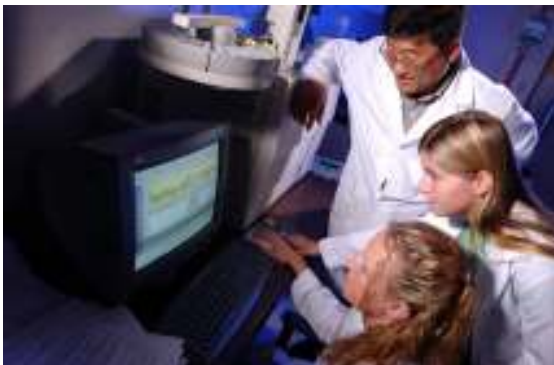
STREAMS (Supporting Talented and Remarkable Environmental And Marine Science Students) Scholarship Program at the University of South Florida St. Petersburg has been established to provide talented but financially challenged students interested in science the support to succeed. STREAMS will provide scholarship funds to support and mentor students through graduation with a bachelor's degree in Environmental Science and Policy and continue into a Master's Program in Environmental Science or Marine Science.

What is STREAMS?

STREAMS is a scholarship program for students interested in Environmental Science at USFSP. The STREAMS Student Scholarship Program will provide opportunities for minorities and women to obtain undergraduate and graduate degrees, gain valuable research experience and engage in professional development activities.



STREAMS scholars will benefit from being mentored by USFSP and USF faculty as well as NSF Florida-Georgia LSAMP Bridge to Doctorate graduate fellows. STREAMS will also facilitate activities designed to prepare student participants for successful Earth system science-related careers.



Environmental Science and Policy at USFSP

The status of the earth's environment has been a major concern since the 1960s. As we enter the 21st century, it represents one of the most critical issues facing nearly all nations individually as well as the earth community as a whole. Increased population, technology, globalization and diminishing natural resources all play an important role in the changing environment. As a consequence, governments at all levels are devoting resources to help understand the problems that we are facing and to aid in their mitigation.



Students completing the Bachelor of Science (B.S.) in Environmental Science and Policy have found employment with government agencies (city, county, state, and federal), private industry, and non-profit organizations. Examples of careers include field scientist, research scientist, policy analyst, lobbyist, conservationist, and educator. STREAMS will assist students graduating with a B.S. in Environmental Science and Policy to go on to attend graduate school in Environmental or Marine Science.

How much funding can I receive through the STREAMS scholarship program?

The scholarships will award between \$3,500 and \$10,000 per academic year for up to four years.

If I receive a STREAMS scholarship, where can this money be applied?

You can use the scholarship funds to pay tuition, buy books, pay for room and board, and other educational expenses.

Can this scholarship be renewed?

Yes, the scholarship can be renewed. Performance and eligibility of all scholars will be reviewed every semester. Upon a successful review, scholarships will be renewed for the next semester for a total of up to four years.

Can I receive other scholarships and financial aid if I receive a STREAMS scholarship?

Yes. Receipt of this scholarship does not prevent you from obtaining other scholarships offered by USFSP.
