(TEACH) Grant
Orientation Dates:**

Eligibility:

- Complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA)
- Be a U.S. Citizen or eligible non-citizen
- Be enrolled as an undergraduate or graduate student in an approved program at a postsecondary educational institution.
- Sign a TEACH Grant Agreement to Serve (ATS)
- Have an overall GPA of at least 3.25 includes all college level coursework accepted by UG admissions for the First Time in college with college credits and transfers

Process of Application:

- Complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA)
- Attend a TEACH Grant College of Education (USF St. Petersburg) Information Session (TCHINF)
- Complete TEACH Grant Initial & Subsequent Counseling (TCHISC) found at www.teach-ats.gov.
- Complete TEACH Grant Agreement to Serve (TCHATS) also found at www.teach-ats.ed.gov.

Agreement to Serve:

- Agree to teach in the high-need field you received your degree in for the majority of the classes you teach in a public or private elementary or secondary school that serves students from low-income families for at least four academic years within the eight calendar years of completing the program of study for which you received the TEACH Grant.
- Failure to fulfill the ATS will make the TEACH Grant convert to a Direct Unsubsidized Stafford Loan with capitalized interest (from the date of initial disbursement).
