



**USF System
Articulation Agreement**

I. Introduction

In order to provide transferability of undergraduate courses to students throughout the USF system, the University of South Florida and the University of South Florida St. Petersburg will articulate USF Foundations of Knowledge courses to fulfill USFSP General Education requirements and vice versa. This articulation agreement will provide students within the USF system enhanced course transferability over students transferring from a different State of Florida institution.

II. Statement of Policy

Effective fall 2009, USF Tampa/Sarasota/Polytechnic will implement the new Foundations of Knowledge curriculum, and USFSP will retain the current General Education requirements. This change will require separate approved course listings by campus and by category. This policy establishes a system-wide articulation agreement to help ensure students retain credit as they transfer from one campus to another within the USF System.

The University of South Florida System will provide for the guaranteed transfer of courses taken from each of the seven categories in the USFSP program to the matching category of courses in the USFT/S/P program and vice versa.

Courses taken toward one category on a specific campus would be transferable to the appropriate corresponding category on the articulated campus.

III. Implementation

This articulation must be implemented prior to student registration for fall 2009 (April 2009). Implementation would include BANNER and SASS updates.

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
