The following conditions pertain to using Academic Renewal I

1. The students must have earned a Florida public A.A. degree from a public two-year institution subsequent to dismissal from USF and prior to the term of readmission to USF.
2. The student re-enters USF as a junior and the USF Grade Point Average (GPA) will be calculated from that point forward.
3. The student is required to earn 60 credits from USF, with a GPA of at least 2.0, subsequent to the Florida public A.A. degree, in order to graduate from USF.
4. All grades earned in the student's academic history will be used in the calculation of GPA's for the purpose of Graduation with Honors from USF.
5. The student may not be eligible to pursue some limited-access majors.
6. **It is the students' responsibility to provide the USFSP Office of Admissions & Records with an official transcript documenting receipt of the Florida public A.A. degree, no later than the end of the fourth week of the term of USF readmission. Failure to do this will result in revocation of readmission, cancellation of USF registration, and a recall of any dispersed financial aid.**
