Mentors assist students with acclimating to campus life at USF St. Petersburg. The SPECTRUM mentors play an integral role in working with students for the first year of their college experience at USFSP. Students will gain an understanding and appreciation of the campus culture, be introduced to co-curricular activities, and receive assistance achieving academic and personal growth.

Qualifications:

- Be an upperclassman at USF St. Petersburg for the 2011-2012 academic year.
- A minimum G.P.A. of 2.5.
- Be in good judicial standing.

Responsibilities:

- Commit to the mission and program objectives of the SPECTRUM Mentor Program.
- Attend periodic meetings throughout the academic year.
- Contact your mentee biweekly.
- Facilitate monthly activities based on your common interests.
- Encourage mentee to participate in campus sponsored events and programs.
- Assist mentees with academic and personal growth.
- Be a representative of the college by presenting a positive outlook and view of the program.
- Serve as a liaison between your mentee and the Office of Multicultural Affairs.
- Attend monthly workshops sponsored by the SPECTRUM Mentor Program.
- Attend field trips.
- Attend end of semester reception/banquet.

Remuneration:

- Each mentor will receive a gift card to Barnes and Noble at the end of the Fall and Spring Semester (upon satisfactory completion of the program) and a certificate of completion.
- Bi-Annual Field Trips.
- Recognition reception/banquet.
